<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>2</sup> A "qualified third party" is (1) a physician licensed to practice in Nevada; (2) a psychiatrist licensed to practice medicine in Nevada and certified by the American Board of Psychiatry and neurology, Inc., or the American Osteopathic Board of Neurology and Psychiatry of the American Osteopathic Association; (3) a psychologist licensed to practice in Nevada; (4) a social worker licensed to practice in Nevada; (5) a registered nurse holding a master's degree in the field of psychiatric nursing and licensed to practice professional nursing in Nevada; (6) a marriage and family therapist or clinical professional counselor licensed to practice in Nevada pursuant to chapter 641A of NRS; (7) any person employed by an agency or service which advises persons regarding domestic violence or refers them to persons or agencies where their request and needs can be met and who is licensed to provide health care pursuant to title 54 of NRS, or is a member of the board of directors or serves as the executive director of an agency or service which advises persons regarding domestic violence or refers them to persons or agencies where their request and needs can be met; or (8) any member of the clergy of a church or religious society or denomination that is tax exempt, who has been chosen, elected or appointed in conformity with the constitution, canons, rites, regulations or discipline of the church or religious society or denomination.
